POETRY EVENTS AT THE BARRON ARTS CENTER

A. <u>Poetswednesday</u> began at the Barron Arts Center in 1978. It is the oldest poetry reading group in the United States. Poetswednesday meets the second Wednesday of each month at the Barron Arts Center and features readings from renowned guest poets along with a free hour workshop. At the conclusion of the reading from the featured poet there is an open MIC in which all attendees can participate. Many readings are accompanied by musicians and attract a varied clientele. Poetswednesday is sponsored through the Township of Woodbridge & the Cultural Arts Commission of Woodbridge.

Student Slam Poetry Event originated as a project for high school students. It consists of individual slam poetry workshops in each of the three high schools within Woodbridge. At the conclusion there is a selection process within each high school with the top three poets from each high school going to the Barron Arts Center for a final competition. This competition is judged by 4 outstanding slam poets and the master of ceremonies is their original instructor. Deborah LeVeglia the head Chair of Poetswednesday presides over the event with extra readings from the four judges. The 4 slam poets rate and select a winner within the elimination process.

Poetswednesdays strengthens both local businesses and the Woodbridge Metro chamber of Commerce by increasing the visibility of our thriving downtown area and restaurants.

Poetswednesday strengthens our visibility through the promotion of the Spoken Word. There are many new visitors each month with an outstanding lineup of Poets and authors who are available without having to commute into New York City to participate within the writer's medium. All programs are offered free of charge with the support of the Township of Woodbridge and the Cultural Arts Commission of Woodbridge.

- B. Poetswednesday at the Barron Arts Center has been a collaborative process dating back to 1978. It brought together writers and musicians while providing a venue to explore and develop their craft under the guidance of many professionals within the spoken word. The recent emergence of the Poetry Slam is a new addition now into its fourth year attracting a whole new generation into our program with the enhancement and visibility working within our school system and the Board of Education.
- C. Poetswednesday and Student Slam Poetry Event support the development/implementation of our Creative Placemaking Plan. Both programs have brought many new people into Woodbridge Township. They in turn have frequented many of our restaurants, stores and hotels. With a high visibility in the arts, they in turn looked for other events within Woodbridge. Most of these events are offered free of charge.
- D. Poetswednesday and Student Poetry Slam expand the local development of the community by bringing more people into Woodbridge Township. It also expands our endeavor by bringing local people into an art community where they than discover all the possibilities available to them which they would never had otherwise discovered.
- Both these projects were conceptual ideas of various writers, poets and musicians. They have designed and implemented the project.
 - Both elements of our poetry projects have been important to neighborhood revitalization, tourism, and business enhancement. They do well in that they bridge the community's age barriers engaging participation from students to seniors.
 - We have partnered with surrounding communities and continue to collaborate with the school system.
