In 2019, the City of Jersey City installed its first municipally-owned electric vehicle charging station near the downtown business district. In 2020-2021, the City rolled out nine additional Level 2 dual-port charging stations across the city. Four of the public chargers were funded through the "It Pays to Plug In: NJ's Electric Vehicle Workplace Charging Grant Program". In total there are ten dual-port stations that are owned and operated by the City.

Dedicated parking spots are reserved for electric vehicle charging exclusively. Electric vehicles may park at these spots without additional permits or fees associated with street parking. The City charges a rate of \$1.60 per hour at the charging stations. These spots have regulatory signage, green striping and parking spot stencils to increase user visibility. Please see the attached images of the public charger in the downtown district.

The charging process is simple: drivers pull into the designated street parking spot, plug their electric vehicle into the charging station, run errands or shop and return to a charged vehicle. Drivers may utilize the ChargePoint application or their ChargePoint RFID card to pay for the transaction.
