Watchung Bottle Cap Collection Information

The Environmental Commission would like residents to know that the plastic bottle cap recycling program at the library is still suspended. The Commission suggests that people continue to collect their caps at home and hold on to them until the program resumes. It is not expected to resume any time soon due to the germs associated with the caps.

The Trex stretchy plastic bag recycling program is also suspended indefinitely. Again, residents are encouraged to save their bags at home until the program is able to resume safely. Shop Rite in Stirling is still recycling and has a bin for plastic bag recycling near their front door.
