What Can I Recycle

What	Where
Cooking Oil Eyeglasses & Sunglasses Hard Covered Books Motor Oil & Antifreeze Paints Stains & Aerosols Propane Tanks Rechargeable Batteries ONLY Shredded Paper Styrofoam Tires (limit 4 tires a month)	At the Recycling Center in Keasbey!
Branches Bulky Rigid Plastics- buckets, laundry baskets, etc. Electronic Waste- Computers, TV's & Printers Mixed Metal	At the Recycling Center in Keasbey OR you can call for a FREE curbside pick up.
Cardboard	Curbside, breakdown boxes to fit into blue recycling cart or bring to the Recycling Center in Keasbey.
Single Stream Items- plastic, tin, glass, aluminum	Curbside, all items must fit inside the blue recycling cart or bring to the Recycling Center in Keasbey.
Appliances	At the Recycling Center in Keasbey. Curbside pick up available for a fee.
Leaves	At the Recycling Center in Keasbey. Check your calendar for free curbside leaf bag pick up dates.
Plastic Bags, Film & Shrink Wrap	At the Recycling Center in Keasbey, Town Hall, All Senior Centers, Community Center & local retailers.
Textiles	At the Recycling Center in Keasbey or at local clothing drop boxes.

The DOs and DON'Ts of Curbside Recycling in Woodbridge

DO RECYCLE

these items in your **BLUE CART**
Always place recyclables loose
in your **BLUE CART**, never bagged.

- Clean and empty aluminum cans (no aluminum foil)
- Clean and empty steel and tin cans and containers (no scrap metal)
- Clean and dry paper (no shredded, soggy or soiled paper)
- Clean, dry and flattened cardboard and paperboard
- Clean and empty plastic bottles, jugs and containers (no plastic bags, hoses or shrinkwrap)
- Clean and empty milk, juice and broth cartons
- Clean and empty glass bottles and jars



DON'T RECYCLE
