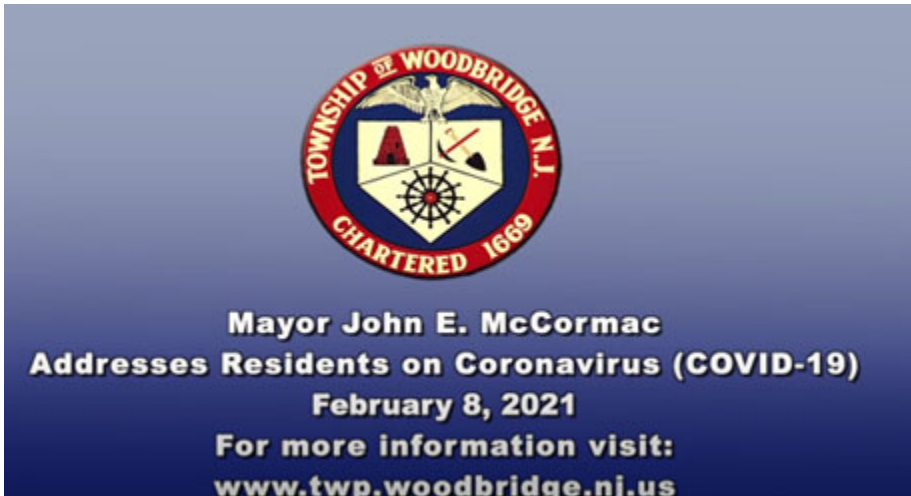

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 8, 2021



This is Woodbridge Mayor John McCormac and today is Monday, February 8.

The Township had our lowest weekend count of new cases of Coronavirus since the middle of November with 131 over three days – 50 on Friday, 33 on Saturday and 48 on Sunday. We are not quite sure if the low numbers are because people could not get to testing sites because of the snow so it will take many more days to really see if this trend continues.

The County, State and the country though are showing similar reductions in cases and in hospital stays and in the rate of transmission.

There were no new cases in outside facilities but we sadly have five new deaths to report in the Township from COVID-19 – a 59 year old male on January 3; 78 year old female on the 10th; 79 year old male on the 12th; 49 year old male on the 31st and an 86 year old male on February 3. Please keep all of the victims in your thoughts and prayers.

Please keep an eye on your homebound neighbors and those living alone and continue to follow the guidelines of good personal hygiene, mask wearing and social distancing.
