Bikes — look for their signature white color — have been installed at three locations: Downtown Woodbridge at Tanzman Park, Ferry Street Park in Sewaren & E. William Street Greenway Entrance in Fords.

You put your credit card into the locks to take out a bike, which you can then borrow for a few hours and then dock the bike back at one of those three bike docks.

The app uses your phone's location tracking to track which of the three bike docks you are near.

MAYOR JOHN E. McCORMAC MESSAGE FRIDAY, JUNE 25, 2021



This is Woodbridge Mayor John McCormac and today is Friday, July 2.

The Township had 15 new cases of Coronavirus from the general public over the last week with nine on Monday and one each of the other six days. Three of the nine were in one household and two were in another. It is great to see such low numbers but Covid is not completely gone yet.

The Township fireworks display is being postponed until Monday due to the high probability of thunderstorms with high winds and lightning after 4 p.m. The same details apply for Monday with doors open at 4:00PM, a local band called Power Train at 5:00PM, presentations at 7:00PM and a group called The Nerds after that with the fireworks at dusk and The Nerds again after the display so stick around and let the traffic clear out.

The Woodbridge Police Department is increasing neighborhood patrols on the days surrounding July 4 in an unprecedented crackdown on the use of illegal fireworks. People setting off these fireworks are subject to arrest and confiscation of all items. These fireworks really impact small children, senior citizens, people with PTSD and many pets and for days people can't get a good night's sleep.

Homeowners can also be responsible for "harboring a nuisance" by allowing these fireworks to be set off from their properties so please think twice before allowing your children or their friends to use your front or back lawns to set off fireworks. The Police cannot always tell who was actually shooting off the fireworks but when they see evidence on the property, they can issue a summons to the homeowner.

We also maintain a database of addresses where prior complaints were received so those areas receive special checks. To report a prior offender's address please call the non-emergency Police line at 732 634-7700.

Our concerts for next week include The Drifters on Doo Wop Monday, Real Diamond on Tribute Tuesday, the great Raul Malo on Eclectic Wednesday, the Kickback Band on Local Band Thursday and the Zac Brown Tribute Band on Country Sunday. All shows are on the concert field behind Woodbridge High School and they all start at 7:30 except Sundays which starts at 7. A local band called HyWay Robbery will appear at Curtains Restaurant in Avenel Saturday at 7.
