Paper Shredding: Accepting only residential paper until the truck is full. Papers will be placed into a common bin prior to shredding to assure nothing will damage the shredder in the truck.





Styrofoam Recycling: Accepting clean, white blocks of expanded polystyrene (EPS) with symbol #6 put in clear plastic bags. Remove any tape, stickers, labels, and cardboard. **NOT Accepting:** food service items, colored EPS or packing peanuts.





Electronic Recycling: Accepting TVs, computers & computer components, printers/copiers/fax, toner/ink Cartridges, audio and video systems, phones, answering machines, video games, cameras, etc.

Not Accepting: Fire alarm, dehumidifier, microwave, fridge, thermostat, equip. with gas/oil, Putrescible items, propane tanks, hazardous waste.





Medicine Take Back: Safely dispose of over-the-counter and prescription medicines no longer needed by taking them inside their bottles to the Project Medicine Drop Box in the police station lobby. **Not Accepting:** liquids, needles, or syringes. njconsumeraffairs.gov



Book Collection: Accepting gently used books. **Not Accepting:** magazines, encyclopedias, or textbooks.
