• Rain Gardens

- Fulton St. Garden 4 shall be examined as a potential Eagle Scout project, Rain Gardens
 1-3 were completed in 2019. Approved
- Rain Garden Inspections and Annual Maintenance shall be undertaken in fall of 2021, and spring of 2022. Refresh training for DPW staff with regard to how to inspect and maintain the gardens will take place in fall 2021 and spring 2022. – Approved
- Living Shoreline
- Living shoreline and ecological restoration on Cliff Road adjacent to Boynton Beach was discussed as a matter of exploratory assessment and review. Approved for concept design.
- Floodplain Restoration
 - o 200 trees to be installed within parcels identified on restoration plans, Nat. Public Lands Day; Sat. Sept. 25th w/ Girl Scouts Approved
 - o Forested wetland implementation within Watson & Crampton neighborhood planned for mid-September and planting late-September.- Approved
 - No mow signs were discussed near and within areas whereby the Township seeks to preserve restoration and flood storage capacity. – Concept Approved, Follow up on edits to sign design.
