# PLACING YOUR BIN

- The bins are best sited on a level, well drained spot
- This allows excess water to drain out
- This allows better aeration
- Worms can get in easier
- Placing a compost bin in a partially sunny spot can help speed up the composting process

- + Frozen Food Boxes
- + Human & Animal Waste

- + Liquids
- + Meat
- + Metal
- + Produce Stickers

- + Staples In Tea Bags
- + Styrofoam
- + Waxed Cardboard









## **COMPOST ESSENTIALS**

The items we add to the bin provide these. Air, water and food are essential in order for the materials to break down.

The materials biodegrade, this means to rot down.

# WORMS AND BEETLES

## What do they do?

- Worms eat away at the matter in the compost bin and break down the material. They also help to add air to the soil.
- Beetles and Flies also eat away at the matter and work together to turn this waste into compost.
